

CLEP/DSST Information

CLEP exams are offered for those who have access to MCAS Miramar on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays at 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 noon. (Note: *military ID is needed for military base access.*)

We also offer testing at our Spectrum campuses Testing Center in San Diego every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday at 10:30am and 1:00pm, every Monday at 10:30am and one Saturday each month at 10:30am. **Appointments are always required.**

In order to make a CLEP/DSST appointment, you must complete step 1. If you are scheduling a CLEP exam you must complete step 2 as well prior to arriving on the day of the exam.

1. (CLEP/DSST) You will first need to schedule an appointment by registering at:

<https://nutesting.mywconline.com> You will be asked to register and provide your first and last name, phone number, student ID number (if you are a National University student), and the name of the exam.

2. (CLEP Tests Only) The second part requires you to go to <https://clep.collegeboard.org/exam>. Here you will select the test you want, pay the fee of the test which is \$80; method of payment is by credit card. You will receive a registration ticket with a voucher number on it; bring this number with you on the day of the test. Active Duty and Reservists are not required to pay the testing or proctoring fee. In order to obtain a ticket voucher without paying please go through the registration process and choose the option where it states that the Dantes fee is waived "but not a Veteran" box. You must bring the voucher, or ticket number with you on the day of the test.

Please note that Active Duty/Reservist military personnel are not charged a testing fee. Veterans can be reimbursed. If you are *not* a National University student/alumni, there is a \$20 proctoring fee in addition to the test fee, payable by cash or check.

The time limit for a CLEP test is 90 minutes. Please allow approximately two hours; The registration procedures and a short pre-test tutorial will take a few minutes before testing begins. (Note: *College Composition CLEP tests are two hours in length due to written essays.*)

Results are available immediately except for the College Composition with Essay exam. If you are taking the College Composition with Essay test, you will receive your results by mail in approximately 2-4 weeks.

On the day of the test, arrive at the Testing Center on time- late arrivals will be rescheduled. Bring two forms of identification (One must be a government-issued photo ID: Drivers License, State ID Card, Passport, or Military ID). The second ID needs to have a photo or signature such as a current student ID, or an unused ID from the choices above. Don't forget the payment info for the test and eyeglasses, if needed.

No food, drinks, phones, notes, books, etc. are allowed. Children, pets, and other companions are not allowed.
