1. On Tuesday, 05 May 2026, a Single Marine Program Council Meeting was held at the Chow Hall. Sergeant Santini, SMP President, called the meeting to order at 11:30. He welcomed everybody and introduced the guest speakers.
2. **Guest Speakers:**
 - a. Bobbie Domingo (Pool Manager) shared details about an upcoming 5v5 flag football tournament held by the Semper Fit Program. They will be hosting tryouts in which teams will be selected with up to 15 players per team and face off on June 27th.
3. **Quality of Life Topics:**
 - a. SgtMaj Brown mentioned there will be up to 21,000 AC units being distributed to all bases on the west coast and that Marines should remain on the lookout for their arrival.
4. **Previous Business:** SMP President, Sgt Santini, discussed previous business.
 - a. **Volunteer/Events/Trips for April:**
 - i. Volunteer events for April were a big success as it was Days of Service Month and the SMP hosted a total of six (6) volunteer opportunities: Easter Bruch at Fairway Café, STEAM Family Book Fair, NMCRS Thrift Store, Ocean Connectors Kayaking, PETCO Ballpark Cleanup and the SMP Monthly Dinner. Due to low participation the PE Fitness Challenge for April was cancelled. The SMP Monthly Dinner had Phil's BBQ catered and served a total of 133 Marines.
5. **Current Business:** SMP Vice President, Cpl Juarez, discussed current business.
 - a. **Volunteer/Events/Trips for May:**
 - i. Reviewed the status of ongoing volunteer events and upcoming activities. Volunteer sign-ups include SoCal Special Olympics with 8 of 10, Build-a-Blend Smoothies with 3 of 3 volunteers, the UFC Watch Party with 6 of 6, the thrift store with 3 of 3, and the monthly

Aside from the UFC watch party, the ADRC will be showing boxing matches on May 10th and 16th; free surf lessons will be available May 19th and for \$80 Marines can sign up to go to K1 Outdoor Circuit on May 23rd.

 - a. **Volunteer/Events/Trips for June:**
 - i.
